

Interview Information BSc (Hons) Speech and Language Therapy

Thank you for your application to study Speech and Language Therapy.

As part of our recruitment process we invite applicants to attend an interview. There will be two interviewers and the interview will last 20-25 minutes. It will take place online using Microsoft Teams. It is not necessary for you to have this software, though you will need an electronic device with a camera, so that interviewers can see you. The purpose of the interview is to give you the opportunity to demonstrate your understanding of what it means to be a Speech and Language Therapist, and to explain why you feel that you would be suited to the course and to the profession. The interviewers will also be evaluating your personal qualities and your values.

You can find the date of your interview on your UCAS Hub, and you will also be sent a Microsoft Teams invitation by email several days before the interview is due to take place. The invitation will tell you the time of your interview and who the interviewers are. It will also provide a weblink to a Course Talk.

It is important that you make yourself available on this day, as we are unable to complete an assessment of your application without the information that we will obtain during the interview. We would be grateful if you could confirm as soon as possible via your **UCAS Hub** that you are able to attend the interview on this date.
