Information to candidates for PGCE (Post Graduate Certificate in Education) Secondary Physical Education

Interviews will take place through Microsoft Teams and candidates will need to be available for either the morning or afternoon of their interview day.

Candidates are expected to dress formally for the interview. Cameras will be required to be on, and it is requested that candidates are able to be in a quiet room un-interrupted for the duration of the interview process.

All candidates will undertake:

- A **2-minute presentation** about themselves and what has influenced them to apply for a PGCE in Physical Education (PE). This should take the form of no more than 2 PowerPoint slides that include just pictures/images.
- A **group interview** which will consist of a 20-minute discussion on the given interview question based on the candidate's research around the area and personal experience.
- An **8-minute individual interview** for the candidates to answer questions posed by the panel.

-**Motivation and inclusion in PE**
